

Answers

Amphibians live the first part of their lives in the water and the last part on the land.

A mammal is an animal that breathes air, has a backbone, produces milk and grows hair at some point during its life.

A fish is an animal which lives and breathes in water. It has gills, fins, and scales.

Snakes, lizards and alligators have skin covered with scales and are classified as reptiles.

Birds have wings, along with a beak and no teeth. Most of the times, their bodies are covered with feathers.
