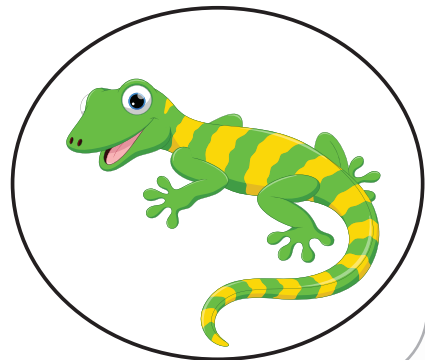
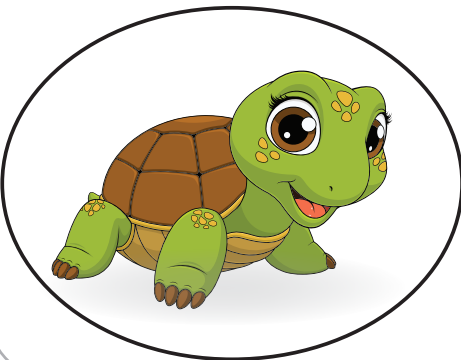
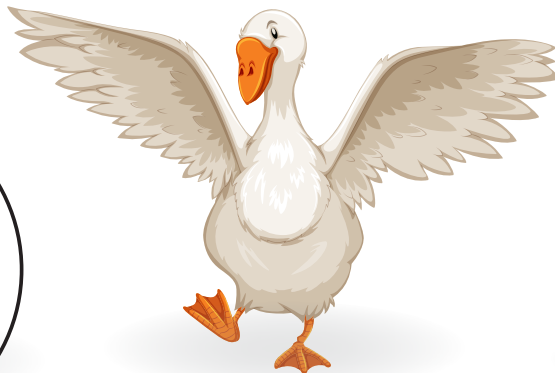
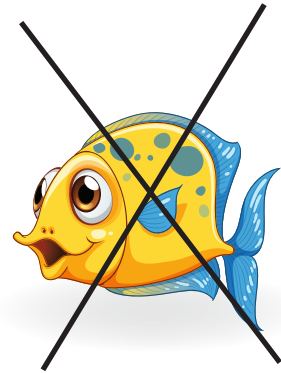
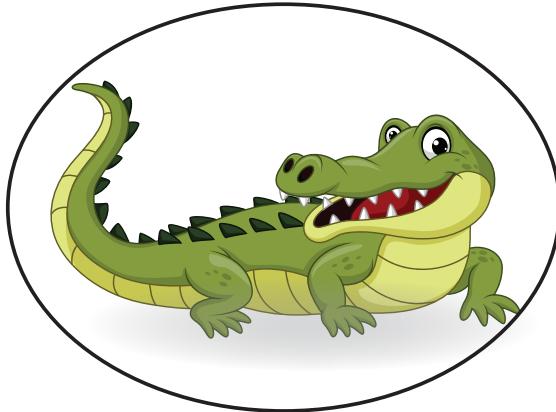
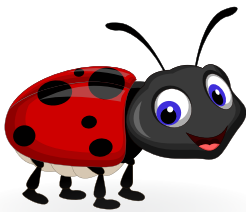


Answers
